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Membership & Role

Membership

The Audit, Risk & Improvement Committee (the Committee) consists of up to 3 voting independent members and 1 non voting councillor representative member. The Committee is appointed by Council and operates in accordance with the *Local Government Act 1993*, the *Local Government (General) Regulation 2021* and the adopted terms of reference based on the model terms of reference outlined in the Office of Local Government Guidelines for Risk Management and Internal Audit for local councils in NSW.

The independent members satisfy the independence and eligibility criteria outlined in the Regulation. The councillor representative also satisfies the skills and experience criteria outlined in the Regulation. The Chair of the Committee has specific responsibilities under the Committee's terms of reference.

The independent members are:

The Councillor representative is Councillor Janin Bredehoeft.

Statutory Responsibilities

Local Government Act 1993 – Section 428A(2) & (3)

The Committee must keep under review the following aspects of the council's operations:

- a) compliance,
- b) risk management,
- c) fraud control,
- d) financial management,
- e) governance,
- f) implementation of the strategic plan, delivery program and strategies,
- g) service reviews,
- h) collection of performance measurement data by the council,
- i) any other matters prescribed by the regulations (see section below).

The Committee is also to provide information to the Council for the purpose of improving the council's performance of its functions.

Local Government (General) Regulation 2021 Clause 216R

The Regulations prescribe that the Committee must also:

- a) oversee the internal audit activities carried out in relation to the council, and
- b) review the performance and efficacy of the activities over each period of 4 years, and
- c) prepare a report on the review that may include recommendations, and
- d) give a copy of the report to the governing body of the council.
