Local Government Act 1993 – Section 428A(2) & (3)	 The Committies must keep under review the following aspects of the council's operations: a) connliance, b) iskinanagement, c) fraud control, d) financial management, e) governance, f) implementation of the strategic plan, delivery program and strategies, g) service reviews, h) collection of performance measurement data by the council, i) any other matters prescribed by the regulations (see section below).
	The Committee is also to provide information to the Council for the purpose of improving the council's performance of its functions.
Local Government (General) Regulation 2021 Clause 216R	 The Regulations prescribe that the Committee must also: a) oversee the internal audit activities carried out in relation to the council, and b) review the performance and efficacy of the activities over each period of 4 years, and c) prepare a report on the review that may include
