Motion

That Council supports the inclusion of the proposed draft Mayoral Statement and Bayside Mayor's name in the Resilient Sydney 2025-30 Strategy, to be launched on 29 April 2025.

Mayoral Minute

Bayside has been a member of Resilient Sydney, a collaboration of all 33 metropolitan councils of Greater Sydney, to develop and implement a city-wide resilience strategy, first published in 2018.

The draft Resilient Sydney Strategy 2025-2030 is a comprehensive plan aimed at enhancing the resilience of Greater Sydney to chronic stresses and acute shocks. This strategy has been developed through a collaborative effort involving all 33 Greater Sydney councils, State and Federal Government partners, community organisations, businesses, and academia.

This Strategy builds on the success of the first Resilient Sydney Strategy 2018.

The strategy outlines 30 actions across five key directions:

1. **Care for our environment:** A city where we care for the environment and live sustainably.
2. **People-centred city:** An equitable city with climate-resilient neighbourhoods.
3. **Connect for strength:** An inclusive city that supports social connections and community agency.
4. **Be ready:** A city where people and organizations are prepared for shock events.
5. **One city:** A city with coordinated governance that people trust.

The strategy also includes case studies of initiatives already underway that support resilience, showcasing the incredible depth of knowledge and collaboration among Greater Sydney councils.

Resilient Sydney is seeking support for a short statement from all mayors to include in the final strategy. The draft mayoral statement is:

Local government plays a critical role in supporting place-based resilience.

The resilience challenges facing Greater Sydney cannot be solved individually. They require a collaborative effort from local, state and federal governments, business and community.

The Resilient Sydney Strategy provides a pathway for collaboration to make Greater Sydney more resilient now and in the future.

Working together, in genuine partnership, will ensure Greater Sydney is a place where all communities thrive.

The published strategy will be made available in early May 2025.
